Youth Dream Hunt

On Saturday, October 6th 2007, an event for kids with life-threatening illnesses and disabilities was held at Tanglewood Ranch and Hunt Club in Lafayette County.

This event was made possible by the United Special Sportsman Alliance. Wings Over Wisconsin was also a sponsor of this event. Eight kids along with family and friends joined in the thrill of this hunt. Many members of the Iowa-Lafayette chapter of Wings Over Wisconsin were there to help and give support to the kids and families.

The kids took some time to shoot clay pigeons before they took to the field for their pheasant hunt. The pheasant hunt was a huge success with many kids getting a chance to shoot their first pheasant. After the hunt and lunch a wagon ride to the local elk ranch was taken. Wildlife Acres has around 900 elk on their ranch and most of the kids and families had a chance to see elk up close for the first time.

Pheasants were donated by the Iowa-Lafayette chapter, Wildlife Acres, Tanglewood Ranch and Jim Mathys. Lunch was provided by Pizza Hut of Dodgeville. Wagons for

the Elk tour were provided by The Farmer's Store in Mineral Point.

A \$1,000.00 donation was presented to Joel Espe, the Vice President of the U.S.S.A. by Ron Burbach, on behalf of the Wings Over Wisconsin Organization.

PHEASANT CASSEROLE Submitted by Jeanne Marchant

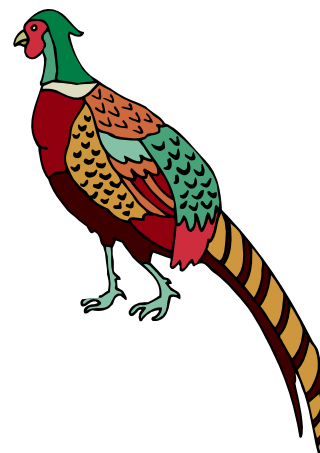
1 Pheasant (cut up) 2 10oz pkgs frozen Broccoli

Steam broccoli and layer pheasant and broccoli in casserole dish.

Dressing:

1/2 cup Mayo	2 cans Cream of Chicken soup
1/2 cup Sour Cream	1 tsp Lemon Juice
1/2 cup Bread Crumbs	Grated Cheese

Combine all dressing ingredients and pour over pheasant and broccoli. Bake 25 to 30 minutes at 325 degrees.
