PHEASANT HUNTS

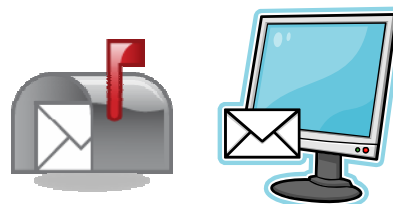

Recipe Corner

Grouse Chowmein

2 16oz cans Chinese vegetables

2 Tbl Cornstarch

3 Chicken bouillon cubes

1 Tbl Soy sauce

1 4oz can Sliced mushrooms

2 Cups cooked / Diced Grouse

1 Tbl margarine

Boil grouse about 10 minutes, cool and dice. Drain liquid from vegetables into a measuring cup and add water to make 2 cups. In sauce pan, add liquid and cornstarch and mix well. Add bouillon cubes. Cook until slightly thick, stir frequently. Add vegetables and soy sauce.

In separate pan, melt margarine and add mushrooms and grouse, brown lightly. Add to vegetable mixture. Serve over rice. Serves 6.
